IT IS FURTHER THE ORDER OF THIS COURT THAT counterdefendant Mead pay an additional \$50,000.00 to counterclaimant for the additional injury caused by imprisoning counterclaimant on March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2017 in defiance of this court's order to cease and desist all actions against counterclaimant until the issues before this court are settled.
- 66. IT IS FURTHER THE ORDER OF THIS COURT THAT the State of Nevada and the United States and all its subdivisions, municipalities, counties townships, villages, towns or any other subdivision falling under the jurisdiction of Nevada and/or the United States, Inc. to update its records removing the cestui que trust THOMAS ARVEL BENSON for which Thomas Arvel Benson is the executor, and Thomas Arvel Benson, Tom A. Benson Thomas Benson, Tom Benson and any other series of characters and/or digits used to identify counterclaimant from their respective jurisdictions;
- 67. IT IS FURTHER THE ORDER OF THIS COURT THAT counterdefendants have acted contrary to constitutional right, power or privilege;
- 68. IT IS FURTHER THE ORDER OF THIS COURT THAT counterdefendants actions were in excess of statutory jurisdiction, authority and short of statutory right;
- 69. IT IS FURTHER THE ORDER OF THIS COURT THAT counterdefendants are permanently enjoined from interfering with claimant's lawful right of free travel;
- 70. IT IS FURTHER THE ORDER OF THIS COURT THAT all actions including Case No. C-17-322203-1 against counterclaimant in the inferior courts are hereby dismissed with prejudice.
- 71. IT IS FURTHER THE ORDER OF THIS COURT THAT charges for violation of 18 USC 241, 18 USC 242, 18 USC 2381, 18 USC 2383 be leveld against counterdefendants Mead,

78. This concludes this case and the order is final upon counterdefendants failing to provide just cause why this order is invalid.
