D. 2004 of the 220th Judicial District Court for said County, upon their oaths present in and to said Court at said term that Michael Scott Townsend, hereinafter styled Defendant, on or about the 30th ay of September, 2004, and before the presentment of this indictment, in the County and State aforesaid, did then and there, with specific intent to commit the offense of capital murder, that is, knowingly cause the death of a peace officer who was acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty and who the Defendant knew was a peace officer, do an act amounting to more than mere preparation that tended but failed to effect the commission of the offense intended, namely, aimed and fired a shotgun at Robert Jolley, a Deputy Sheriff of Comanche County, Texas, and Defendant used a deadly weapon, to wit: said shotgun,
