23. of Taxes for City and County of New York, 2 Black 620 (1863)  
24. Please take mandatory notice (Federal Rules of Evidence 201 (d))  
25. that Plaintiff has a lawful right to proceed without cost, based  
26. upon the following law:

27. The U.S. Supreme Court has ruled that a natural individual  
entitled to relief is entitled to free access to its judicial  
tribunals and public offices in every State in the Union (2  
Black 620, see also Crandell v. Nevada, 6 Wall 35). Plaintiff  
should not be charged fees, or costs for the lawful and
